Once again, I would like to wish you a Happy Easter. Easter, as we know, is not just a one-day celebration, but an entire season that lasts for 50 days. The Easter Season ends on Pentecost Sunday, which will be May 19 this year. I pray that this Easter Season will be for you a season of joy, peace, and feasting.

This is a big week for our parish: our native son, Michael Scanga, will be ordained to the diaconate this Saturday, April 13, at 10:30 am at St. Mark Catholic Center, 429 E Grandview Blvd, Erie PA, 16504. Child Abuse Prevention Month- Reporting Child Abuse: It is every adult's moral responsibility to report known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to the responsible authorities. Physical and sexual abuse of minors are pervasive societal problems, and only concerted and sustained efforts by all adults in every segment of society can help to protect children and youth. In the 2022 Pennsylvania statewide report there were 4,992 substantiated reports of child abuse and 440 more cases in the court system. 2,056 or 38.2% of the substantiated reports were for sexual abuse, 1,501 were physical abuse. 62.2% of the victims were female. Parents remain the persons most responsible for abuse of their children. *To report child abuse, call Childline at 1-800-932-0323* (*anytime 24/7*).
